He laid the foundation of the institution, with the sole aim of providing quality education to its pupils. It was under his loving patronage that the school came up as a full-fledged Senior Secondary Institution imparting quality education to the children of Meerut and surrounding areas.

Following the footsteps of the founder and taking the legacy ahead Dr. Sarojini Agarwal, Chairperson of the school left no stone unturned to keep his dream alive and to fulfill this dream of Madam, Dr. O.P Agarwal, the Chairman of the institution walked hand in hand bringing the school to greater heights and today it fosters an enriched educational life to over 3000 students.

Facilities at CVPS- Infrastructure forms the crux of any progressing school. CVPS has always made sure that the right kind of facilities are created which further benefits the overall teaching process. Be it sporting infrastructure or academic infrastructure the school has created ample and optimum facilities.

Laboratories: The school has well-equipped facilities to teach the three separate science labs i.e Biology, Chemistry and Physics. In addition to this, the school has Computer Science lab, Geography

Lab, Home Science Lab, Fashion Studies, Fine arts Lab and. In this era of advanced technology CVPS is the only school in Meerut having Artificial Intelligence, machine learning, and 3 D printing lab.

Sports: At CVPS we have a full-fledged acrylic Basketball court matching international standards. Special coaching by referees is also being provided within the school for Basketball, Volleyball, badminton, cricket and football.

Under the able guidance of Madam Principal, Sri C S Agarwal Inter School Basket Ball Tournament is conducted every year. Playgrounds are the perfect place for children of pre-primary classes to engage in play. It is the place where kids develop crucial physical, social, emotional, and imaginative skills. Besides, a golf car is introduced for the kindergarteners for smooth to and fro movement in the school campus.

In-House Career Guidance and Counselling: Career guidance is organized for the students at the personal and professional level to choose the right career which is most important for their future.

Wellness Centre- The school has a panel of specialist medical practitioners available for consultation. There is a periodical health check-up of all the pupils.

Surveillance and security- Keeping in mind the safety of the students, CCTV cameras are installed in every nook and corner of the campus which helps in monitoring and keeping track of activities taking place in school premises.

The most awaited day arrived with a lot of cheerfulness and accolades when the final result of CBSE Class XII & X was declared. The students left no stone unturned in bringing laurels to the school by achieving commendable scores.

Vansh Verma crossed all leaps and bounds and scored 99.8% securing 1st position in school thus becoming the prestigious CBSE ALL India Rank 2 along with District Topper. Apurva Kaushik scored 98.6% and grabbed 2nd rank with Anshuman Singh who bagged the 3rd position by attaining 97.8%. Adding to the galore of accolades 14 students scored 100 out of 100 marks and portrayed an exemplary result.

Shubhra Varshney from Science stream scored 98.8% and secured first rank whereas Sagar Poonia and Chirag Malik procured the second rank by scoring 97.8%. Yash Jangid scored 97.6% and bagged third rank.

From the Commerce stream Tishika Patni, Preksha and Anshika secured 1st, 2nd and 3rd position by scoring 96.4%, 96.2% and 92.2% respectively.

Anchal chalked up 97% and secured the first position, followed by Aarti Nagar who attained 96.8% and bagged second rank and Divisha acquired 3rd rank by attaining 95.2% percent in Humanities. Another feather was added to the cap of the school as 24 students scored 100 out of 100.

The students of X and XII were awarded with cash prize by the school management. Vansh Verma was bestowed with a cheque of Rs.51000/- as he procured the All India rank #2 in his matriculation examination. Shubra Varshney received a cheque of Rs.11000/-, Sagar Poonia and Chirag Malik of Rs 5000/-, Yash Jangid Rs.3000/-, Apoorva Kaushik Rs. 2100/- and Anshuman Singh of Rs.1100/- along with an appreciation certificate and a memento.

The Respected Chairman Dr. O.P Agarwal, Principal Ms. Anita Tripathi and Director Dr Himani Agarwal congratulated the students and encouraged the learners to follow the footsteps of the toppers and continue the legacy.
